Spring Clean-Up - Dumpsters will be available for your use at East Park (700 East Main) April 30th – May 8th. Remember please **DO NOT** discard these items in the dumpsters: tires, automotive batteries, motor oil, antifreeze, chemicals, ashes, fireworks, and paint.

Metal recycling bins will be available for any metal (aluminum, steel, etc.). Please remember that refrigerators will be accepted only if Freon is drained. Junk cars will also be accepted during our spring cleanup. You must provide Hyrum City the title to the vehicle. If you have any questions or need assistance, please call the city office at 245-6033.

The following household hazardous waste items are FREE to dispose of at the Logan Landfill Hazardous Waste Facility 153 North 1400 West, Logan (Commercial Hazardous Waste is NOT accepted): Antifreeze, Batteries, Bleach, Computers & Computer Monitors, Fertilizers & Other Yard Chemicals, Gasoline & Unwanted Fuels, Household Cleaning Agents, Insecticides/Pesticides/Fungicides, Items That Contain Mercury, Motor Oil, Paint, Paint Thinner, Pool & Spa Chemicals, Propane Cylinders, CRT Televisions, Transmission Fluid, and any Product With The Words Caution/Warning/Or Danger On The Label. Tires can be disposed of from \$2-\$10 per tire depending on size.
