**Mayors Message** – Happy New Year! 2014 was a great year and we are looking forward to a great 2015. Our new city office will be built which will help us better serve the citizens of Hyrum. Development will continue on the Child and Family Support Center as well as our new senior housing development across from the Senior Center. Also, JBS Swift Company will begin construction of their new box cooler. Our parks staff will finish construction on the restrooms at Blacksmith Fork Park during the winter months, and many new homes will be built, to name a few.

There are some things as citizens that you can help with. We occasionally have vandalism and damage done at our parks. It is helpful if you will report anything suspicious that you may notice. Please remember that ONLY cardboard recycling materials are allowed in the recycling bins at East Park. Inappropriate use could result in them being removed.

My priority continues to be on customer service and making sure your tax money is being used wisely. Hyrum is a great place to live, which is mostly because of the people who live here. Thank you!

**Winter Parking Restrictions** – Parking is not allowed on city streets or within ten feet of roadway pavement in any municipal right-of-way between the hours on 12:00 midnight and 8:00 a.m. unless such vehicle is in a driveway approach or otherwise parked behind the curb where curb exists. This law allows for snow removal and is in effect between November 1<sup>st</sup> and April 1<sup>st</sup>, even when there is no snow.

**Hyrum City Ski Night** – Hyrum residents are invited to Beaver Mountain on Tuesday, January 6<sup>th</sup> for night skiing from 5:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. with rental equipment and lift passes available beginning at 4:30 p.m. Ski & board rentals will be available for \$12, performance skis \$18 and lift tickets for \$12. Pre-register for beginner group lessons offered for those who have never skied (5 years +) or snowboarded (7 years +) for \$12. Lessons begin at 5:30 p.m. and at 7:00 p.m. Please call the Hyrum City Office to let us know how many from your family plan on attending the ski night as well as those interested in lessons. This will assist Beaver Mountain to staff enough people to help you have an enjoyable evening.

**Business Licenses** – All current business licenses need to be renewed. If renewal is not made by January 30<sup>th</sup> a late fee will be assessed. If you are starting a new business, please come into the Hyrum City Office and pick up an application. There is a \$10 application fee plus the following: home occupation business \$20; and commercial business \$75. Doing business without a business license is considered a Class B Misdemeanor. If you have any questions, please contact the Hyrum City Office.

**Dog Licenses** – Any dog(s) six (6) months or older is required to be licensed with Hyrum City. Dogs are required to be licensed even if they stay inside your home or never leave your yard. The license fees are as follows:

Neutered/Spayed dogs - \$8 Male dogs - \$12 Female dogs - \$15  
A veterinarian certificate is required to verify rabies vaccination and the dog being neutered or spayed. All dogs must be licensed by Friday, February 27<sup>th</sup>. After February 27<sup>th</sup> a \$10 late fee will be assessed in addition to the regular license fee. Owners will be issued a citation for failure to have his/her dog properly licensed. Also, please remember that City Ordinance permits a maximum of **two dogs per household**.

**Hyrum History Book** – Stop by the City Office to purchase your copy of the new Hyrum History Book available for \$38 each (after 12/19). We are super excited to finally have a record of the history of Hyrum from the 1970's to today. Special thanks to those who served on the committee or provided information to make this book possible.
